New Professional Award - This award is presented in order to formally recognize those individuals that have made significant contributions as a new professional within the financial aid profession. The award is given according to the following policies and procedures:

- Individual representative of any regular or associated ISFAA member Institution. The representative must be a current member of the Association.
- The awardee must have been in the financial aid profession for less than five years.
- The awardee must have made significant contributions at the institutional, state, regional and/or national levels.

Distinguished Service Award – This award is presented in order to formally recognize those individuals who have made exemplary contributions to the financial aid profession and to the Association. The award is given according to the following policies and procedures:

- Individual representatives of any regular or associated ISFAA member institution. The representative must be a current member of the Association.
- Leadership activities and achievements primarily within the financial aid profession or the higher education community.
- A career in the financial aid profession which has been marked by long-term service to the Association, fellow professionals and students.

Retirement Award – Please let us know of any colleagues who have retired from the financial aid profession due to reasons of health, age or institutional eligibility. This individual must be a regular, associate or affiliate member of ISFAA. The retirement must have taken place during the current year and have occurred prior to the annual Spring Conference.
